Construction crews began work Wednesday on the Winchester Street/Key Road roundabout in Keene, starting with the removal of the concrete median.

Starting next Monday, July 11, traffic will be diverted to the west side of the street (the Key Road side), while work begins on the east side. According to City Engineer Donald Lussier, after this work is complete, traffic will be diverted to the east side for work on the west side. Access to businesses will be maintained throughout construction, according to the city. The roundabout is anticipated to be finished in late November or early December.
